

Organization – Section presentations were well prepared and organized.









Overall – What is your overall rating of the teaching assistant?





- Doeun was an excellent TA. Her discussion sections always clarified and expanded lecture material, and her expertise in R programming was valuable in troubleshooting a variety of students' erroneous code.
- Every time we were paired into groups and working on the assignment of the week it felt a little silly and wasteful of time to just raise my hand every time my code wouldn't run properly, when we could have all gone through examples together. That's really my only critique, of the format, the content was really helpful and it was great to have a space to work on the assignments with classmates.
- I love this class. Best TA and always helped during sections. Perfect balance between having students figure out problems on their own and receiving assistance from staff.
- I really liked this TA. She did a great job of answering all the questions we had.
- She was really nice and helpful but occasionally it felt like she didn't fully understand how to help. But overall she was great at explaining things and I felt really comfortable asking for help.

- Teaching assistant didn't really teach, students taught each other, wish they would explain more in class
- This discussion was very helpful and the T.A really displayed her knowledge of the subject with the discussion assignments. She was constantly updating us as well what the professor wanted from us in the assignments.
- This section was extremely useful in relation to understanding R studio and learning how to code. Given that the coding assignments take up a large portion of your grade having the TA guide the students through the assignments and help us understand our mistakes was extremely valuable in my success with the course.
